I. Essential Job Function:

ROPES

- Create a schedule with the Full Service Community Schools program to determine which campus to provide ROPES and/or Prevention Services to and which day
- Create lesson plans using ROPES activities and/or Prevention Services that are appropriate for age group
- Use ROPES and Prevention activities trained in to gain participation from the group
- Know the issues of the group and develop activities to improve behaviors based on the issues
- Process with the group to improve behaviors.
- Assume other duties and responsibilities designated by the Chief or Designee.
- Ensure that all referrals and documentation are met in accordance with statistical direction. Maintain student records to ensure compliance with established policies and procedures.
