DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR YOUNG COUNTY

WHEREAS, THE County of Young and surrounding areas on the 23rd of January, 2026 (and days following), are under imminent threat of severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

THE THREAT OF EXTREME WINTER STORM, EXTREME COLD, ACCUMULATION OF FROZEN PRECIPITATION AND POTENTIAL FOR THE IMMINENT THREAT OF WIDESPREAD SEVERE DAMAGE, INJURY OR LOSS OF LIFE OR PROPERTY; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Young County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF YOUNG COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby proclaimed for Young County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, this Declaration of the local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Young County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and filed promptly with the County Clerk of Young County.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this Declaration of the local state of disaster activated the Young County Emergency Management Plan.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. **ORDERED** this the 23rd day of January, 2026.


