Agenda Topics

ITEM NO. 1. Call to order - All stand if convenient.

THEN, County Judge, Edwin "Win" S Graham IV, called the meeting to order and made note that all Commissioners were present and that the meeting had been posted in the manner and for the time required. Commissioner's Court was recording.

ITEM NO 2. Invocation was given by Commissioner Scott Shook followed by the U.S. Pledge and Texas Pledge.

ITEM NO 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS, ANNOUNCEMENTS AND PRESENTATIONS-NO ACTION ITEM(S).

 Public Comments-County Judge Edwin "Win" S Graham IV advised that he had written to Plug Power and had received a response confirming the verbal agreement that Young County would receive a pilot payment for roughly \$293,000.00 in January 2024.

ITEM NO. 4. Consider County Clerk Minutes from Previous Meeting-November 13, 2023.

NEXT, Commissioner Jimmy Wiley made a motion to accept the Minutes of November 13, 2023 as presented by Ann Ford, County Clerk; Outlined in Exhibit "A". Motion was seconded by Commissioner Stacy Creswell and carried 5-0.

ITEM NO. 5. Consider Treasurers Financial Report/Updates on Securities Pledged-Presented by County Treasurer Kyle Milam.

County Treasurer Kyle Milam, presented the update on securities pledged by Ciera Bank and advised that he is in the process of making application for the government pool investments. See Exhibit "B".

ITEM NO. 6. Consider Auditors Budget Amendments / Vouchers Payable.

NEXT, Commissioner Scott Shook made a motion to approve vouchers for FY2023 presented by County Auditor Cheryl Roberts in the amount of \$14,842.39 and that \$14,842.39 was taken from the General Fund; Outlined in Exhibits "C". Motion was seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Wiley and carried 5-0.

FURTHER, vouchers for FY2024 were presented in the amount of \$114, 315.43 and that \$71,849.83 was taken form the general fund, Outlined in Exhibit "D".

NEXT, Commissioner Stacy Creswell made a motion to approve the FY2024 vouchers; Motion was seconded by Commissioner Scott Shook and carried 4-0-1. Commissioner Jimmy Wiley abstained.

ITEM NO. 7. Discuss/Consider Final Approval for Build Out on Annex-Presented by Justin Gilmore, Level 5 Architecture-Commissioner Jimmy Wiley advised that the project contained a 230-day completion date and a change was made for the county to retain 10% of fees until completion.

NEXT, Commissioner Jimmy Wiley made a motion to accept as stated between Young County and Mann Made Construction; Outlined in Exhibit "E". Motion was seconded by Commissioner Scott Shook and carried 4-1. Commissioner Stacey K Rogers opposed.
