

**COMMISSIONERS COURT MINUTES**

Notice is hereby given that a regular meeting of the Young County Commissioners Court will be held on MONDAY – May 9, 2022, at 9:31 a.m. in the courtroom of the Young County Court, Young County Courthouse, 516 Fourth Street, Room 106, Graham, Texas, for the purpose of discussing and taking any necessary action on the below identified matters.

ITEM NO. 1. Call to order - All stand if convenient.

THEN, County Judge, John C. Bullock, called the meeting to order and made note that all were present and that the meeting had been posted in the manor and for the time required.


