The Court reserves the right to take any and all appropriate actions regarding the redistricting of Young County political boundaries, including the acceptance of new boundaries for the Commissioners Court Precincts, modification of any boundaries, and/or tabling the pending proposals for later consideration and/or action.

After some discussion and upon commissioner' request, Judge Bullock contacted attorney John Redington with Allison, Bass & Magee our contracted counsel or the purpose of redistricting the necessary political boundary lines of Young County. Counselor Redington appeared by virtual meeting with electronic maps and adjusted lines and populations as requested and researched by the Court. NOTE: No member of the public hearing in person or in virtual appearance chose to make any comment or suggestion during this hearing.

THEN, Commissioner Stacey K. Rogers made a motion to adopt the Redistricting Plan #2 including change made in the City of Graham for Precinct #1 and the rural eastern parts of Precinct #3; outlined in Exhibit "A". Motion was seconded by Commissioner Matt Pruitt and carried 4-1 Commissioner Jimmy Wiley opposing.

No Changes made in the two Justice of the Peace Precincts. There are not voting precincts less than 50 and none greater than 5000 and require no alterations




ITEM NO. 4. Adjourn/Recess.


Stacy Creswell, Commissioner Pct #1
